

UN Convention on the Law of the Sea

Article 117

... duty to take, or to cooperate ... for the conservation of the living resources of the high seas.

Article 118

... States ... shall enter into negotiations with a view to taking the measures necessary for the conservation of the living resources concerned.



The 2011 Package

An international legally binding instrument under the United Nations Convention on the Law of the Sea on the conservation and sustainable use of marine biological diversity of areas beyond national jurisdiction

- Marine genetic resources, including questions on the sharing of benefits,
- Measures such as area-based management tools, including marine protected areas,
- Environmental impact assessments,
- Capacity-building and the transfer of marine technology





Atlas of Marine Protection (mpatlas.org) compared to World Database on Protected Areas (WDPA)





- OSPAR (Regional Seas) lacks authority over fisheries
- NEAFC (Regional Fisheries Management Organization) would not use its fisheries authority to close OSPAR-designated MPAs
