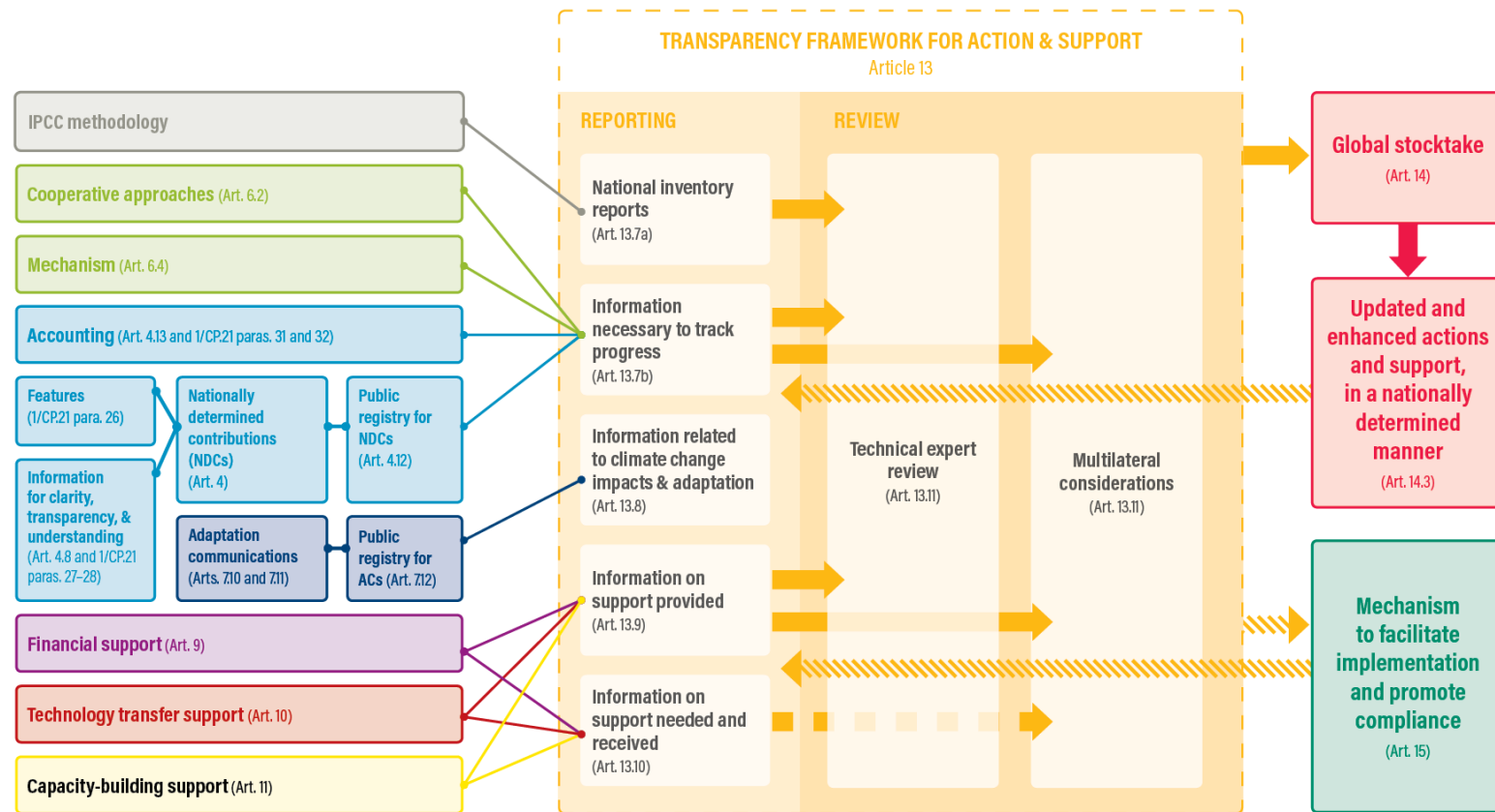

→ = linkage within Article 13    - - - - - → = nonmandatory linkage within Article 13

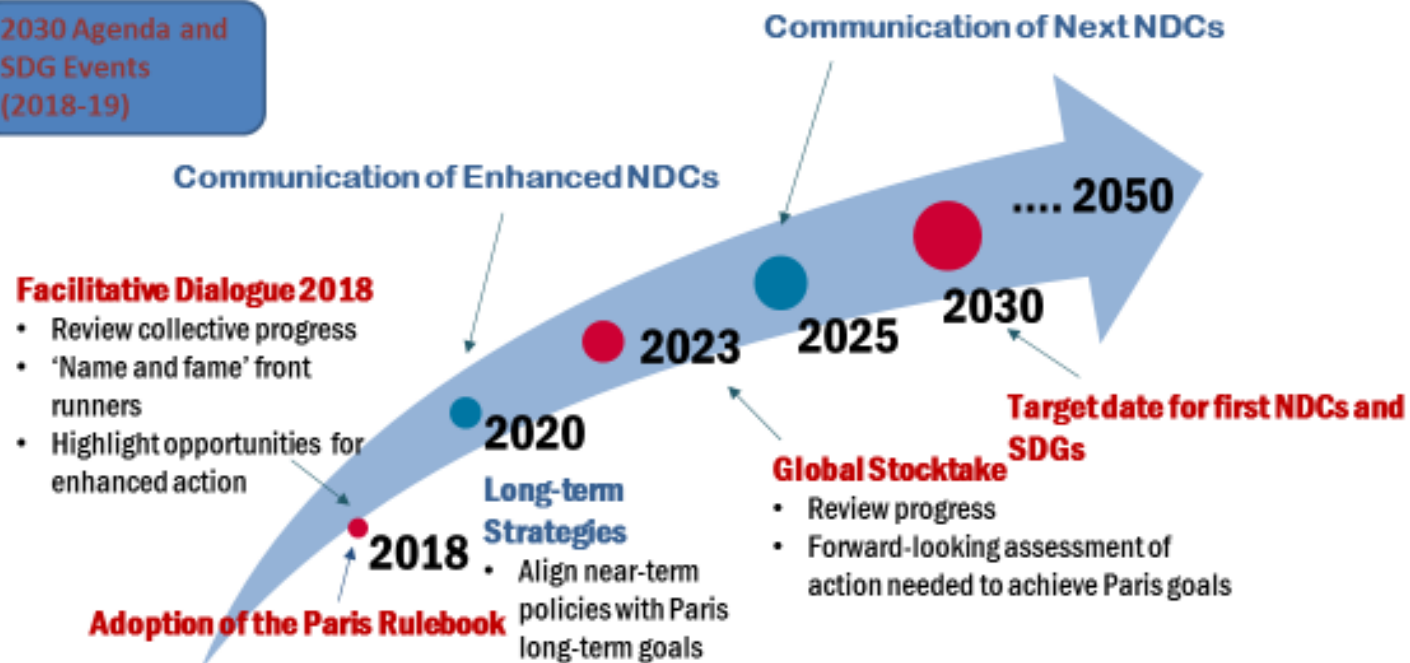
→ (dashed) = potential linkage explored in this paper with Article 13    → (thick red) = linkage within Article 14

# THE FD2018 PROVIDES AN OPPORTUNITY TO:

- Assess the **latest scientific information** based on the IPCC Special Report on 1.5°C.
- Assess the **adequacy of collective efforts** and **collective progress already made**, including the efforts of non-state actors.
- **Identify and share lessons learned.**
- **Identify specific opportunities** to enhance ambition and accelerate implementation, including sectoral, high-mitigation potential, and/or regional opportunities.
- **Naming and faming frontrunners.**
- **Align NDCs with long-term planning and development strategies.**
- Build of major events such as the **Global Climate Action Summit in California.**

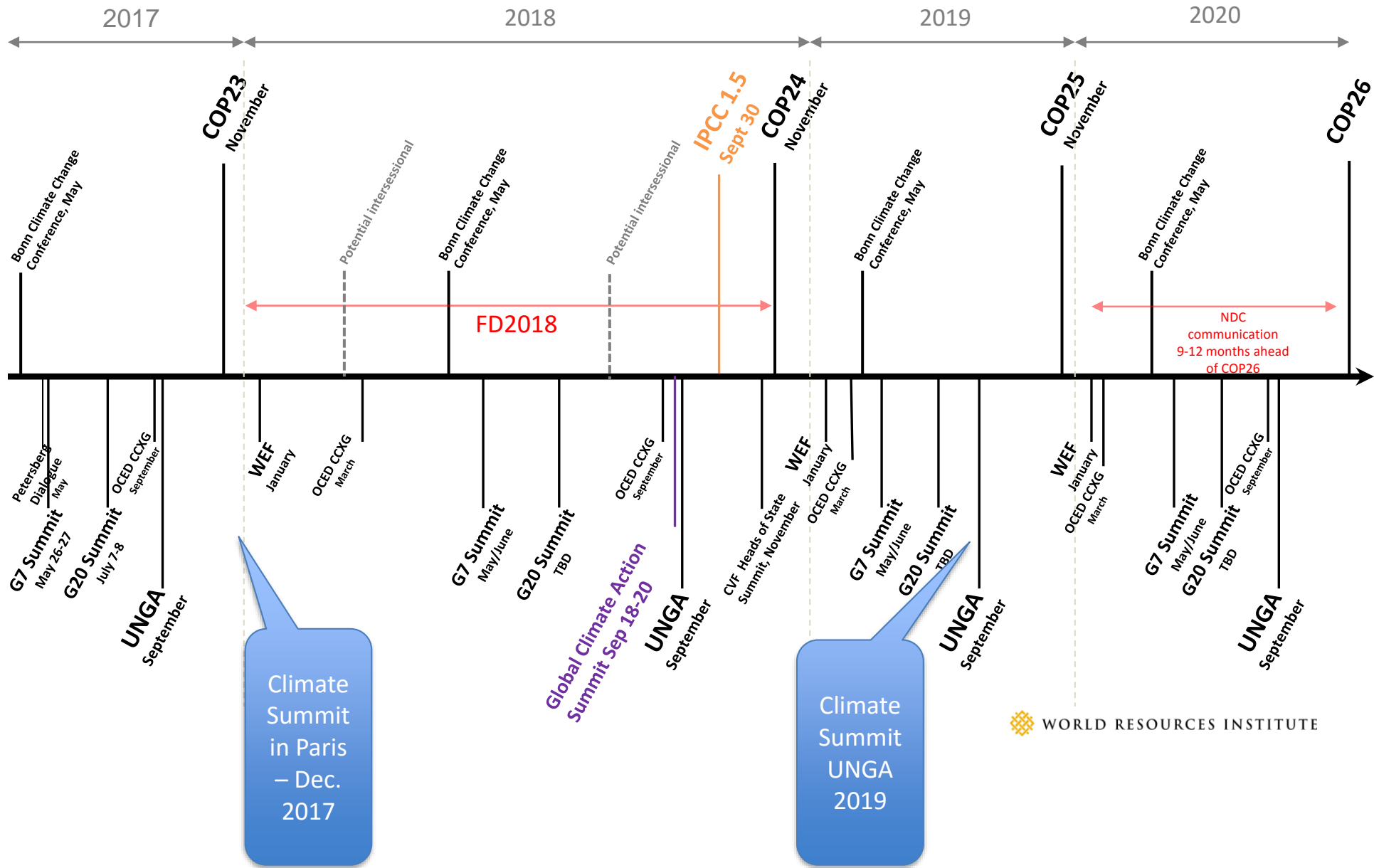


# Keeping Momentum with Global Climate Action

The Marrakech Partnership is a forum for all non-state and subnational actors (NSA) to engage collectively in international climate governance:

- In some countries, NSA play a much larger role in climate action than national governments and can progress more quickly
- There will be a climate action summit in California in 2018 which may provide input to national governments and the FD2018 to showcase what can be done
- Tracking of progress and accounting will be much more important moving forward
- Empowering through the right governance process
